**1912** Sold by Agnes Cochrane or Allan wife of Basil Allan, Painter and Decorator 52 Upper Brook St Chorlton on Medlock, Manchester to Elizabeth Hannah James or Tait, wife of Robert Tait.

**1912-13 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Elizabeth H Tait, wife of Robert L Tait, painter, Gatehouse, owned a house in Fleet Street that was empty.

**1921-22 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Elizabeth H Tait, wife of Robert L Tait, painter, Gatehouse, owned a house in Fleet Street that was occupied by James Gillone, draper.

**1930-31 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Robert L Tait, painter, Gatehouse, owned a house in Fleet Street that was occupied by Jane Gillone, widow.

**1940-41 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Robert L Tait, painter, 26 High Street, owned an unidentified house in Fleet Street that was occupied by M K Gillone, spinster, teacher.  
*[personal recollection suggests that this was 19 Fleet Street]*

**1950-51 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Robert L Tait, painter, 26 High Street, owned an unidentified house in Fleet Street that was occupied by James Kelly, joiner.

**1953** Sold by John Tait to Elizabeth Brown Simpson.

**1960** Property passed to H M Remembrancer, which had fallen to Her Majesty as ultimo haeres. Jane Kelly had inherited from Elizabeth Simpson, formerly of Ellangowan Hotel, Creetown.

**1960-61 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Miss Jane G Kelso-Kelly owned and occupied 19 Fleet Street.

**1961** Sold by H M Remembrancer in Scotland as donee in trust of estate of late Miss Jane Gwendolyn Kelso Kelly in trust to Margaret Bryan.

**1970** Sold by Margaret Bryan to J B and T T Clark.

**1977** Sold by James Black Clark and Thomas Telfer Clark to Stewart Henderson, farmer, Low Balannan, Ringford.

**1980** Sold by Stewart Henderson to Leslie Wells Rutherford.
