1857 The whole property appears to have been sold to William Smith Sutherland.

1859-60 Anwoth Valuation Roll :

William Smith Sutherland, bank agent, Gatehouse, owned a house and garden in Gatehouse that was occupied by Mrs Amelia Houston. Sutherland also owned other property where annual rent was <£4 p.a.

Thomas Tomlinson, innkeeper, Fleet Street, Gatehouse, owned a house in Fleet Street that was occupied by Alexander McGill, dyker.

1914 Registered in name of John Wilson, 44 Arundel Street, Walton, Liverpool.

1950-51 Anwoth Valuation Roll : Ellen Wilson, widow, owned and occupied the house at 21 Fleet Street.
