◀ Chronology of Ownership & Occupancy ▶

1794	Initial feu to John Pape [32ft 3in], surgeon in Gatehouse, as part of a plot of land with 100ft frontage onto Fleet Street. He planned to construct a new mill, but economic conditions changed, his business venture failed, and he sold the land in 1798 for construction of house nos. 23, 25, 27 & 29. Nos 23, 25 & 27 became the property of Samuel McMillan, merchant in Gatehouse.
1799	Samuel McMillan
1830	Disposition by Samuel McMillan to daughter Susan McMillan or McWhae, spouse of John McWhae, baker (east half of tenement) and Isabella McMillan (west half of tenement), eventually inherited by Peter Brown McWhae, Australia and Alexander Brown McWhae, Liverpool

1878-79 Anwoth Valuation Roll : Alexander Brown McWhae, railway clerk, 8 Clarence Grove, Everton, Liverpool owned a house and garden in Fleet Street that was occupied by William Jessop, Inland Revenue Officer. McWhae also owned property in Garden Street with rental <\$4p.a..

1884-85 Anwoth Valuation Roll : Alexander Brown McWhae, railway clerk, 64 Clarence Grove, Everton, Liverpool owned a house and garden in Fleet Street that was empty.

1887 Bond by Alexander Brown McWhae, Everton over Fleet St house 32ft 1in, and houses in Back Fleet St 67ft 2 in. Charter of Novodamus of Margaret Radcliffe or McWhae, who eventually became owner of the property.
