1849 Title of John McConchie, Cambret, who had Precept of Clare Constat from Horatio Murray Stewart. John McConchie was the only son of the now deceased Jane Brown or McConchie, wife of William McConchie, farmer in Pibble, deceased and only sister of deceased James Brown, his uncle.

1849 Sasine of John McConchie, Cambret, who inherited from his uncle James Brown. McConchie passed the property to James Gordon in Bar of Bagbie, in life rent and from him to William Gordon in Woodhead in fee.

Agnes Dunkeld appears to have first married Robert Gordon at Dalry (Kbts) in 1859, and she married Robert Kelly at Dalry (Kbts) in 1876. Robert Kelly died in 1880 and Agnes then married James Logan in 1884. This explains the 2 step-daughters in the above family of James Logan.

1914	Disposition by James Gordon to James Gordon Heron.					
1921-22	Anwoth Valuation Roll :	James Gordon Heron (a minor) owned, per Elizabeth Heron (<i>presumably his mother</i>) 2 houses in Fleet that were both tenanted by James Heron, mariner (<i>presumably his father</i>).				
<i>James Gordon Heron's parents were probably James Heron & Elizabeth Kelly who were married at Anwoth in 1897. If the transaction in 1923 took place and the disposition was from James <u>Gordon</u> Heron, then he would have transferred ownership to Elizabeth <u>his mother</u> (not wife).</i>
