

## 33 Fleet Street - Hamewith



### ◀ Chronology of Ownership & Occupancy ▶

- 1794** 1<sup>st</sup> feu to Ebenezer Hornsby [35ft], schoolmaster, Dumfries. *[also feued no.31 at the same time].*
- 1802** Sold to Thomas McMillan, bookseller, Kirkcudbright.  
Dwelling house possessed by William McConchie, weaver, Thomas Ewart, tailor and widow Tait.
- 1811** Sold to Robert McNish, merchant, Gatehouse.
- 1812** Sold to Alexander Clark, Laurieston.
- 1835** Sold to Josiah Clark, merchant at Wetherby.
- 1836** Sold to Jane Dickson wife of Alexander Dickson, miller Skyreburn Miln.

*The house was owned by the Dickson family until 1897 but the census shows no sign of Dickson's living at this address from 1841 to 1891.*

**1922** Sold by John Belford, sometime Master Mariner now coal merchant, to Caroline Glover.

**1930-31 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Caroline Glover owned the house called Hamewith in Fleet Street, per R S Glover, solicitor. The property was occupied by Robt S Glover.

**1933** Sold by Caroline Glover to Jane Kirk or Kennedy.

**1940-41 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Jane Kennedy, widow, owned and occupied the house Hamewith in Fleet Street.

**1950-51 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Jane Kennedy, widow, owned and occupied the house Hamewith in Fleet Street.

**1954** Disposed by Jane Kennedy or Mitchell to Samuel Campbell.

**1960-61 Anwoth Valuation Roll :** Samuel Campbell owned and occupied 33 Fleet Street, Hamewith.

**1991** Sold to Kenneth and Jacqueline Whittaker.
