Penny christened 25-05-1947 (Whit Sunday). Graham christened on Penny's 3rd birthday. John christened 04-03-1962.          Christopher buried 15-05-1954 at Bulwell Northern Cemetery plot 19, sector XD13 (approved 14-05-1954).</p> <p>Des &amp; Audrey were embarrassed about the fact that Penny was expected when they were married. Hence they tried to convince their children that they were married in 1945. The deception included a false entry in the family bible, a false copy of their marriage certificate, celebrating their silver wedding after only 24 years, and preparing for a ruby wedding in Gatehouse after 39 years.</p> <p>Addresses were : 9 Chatham Street, Bulwell, 72b Landcroft Crescent, Bestwood Estate, 337 Hucknall Lane, Bulwell Hall Estate (all in Nottingham). 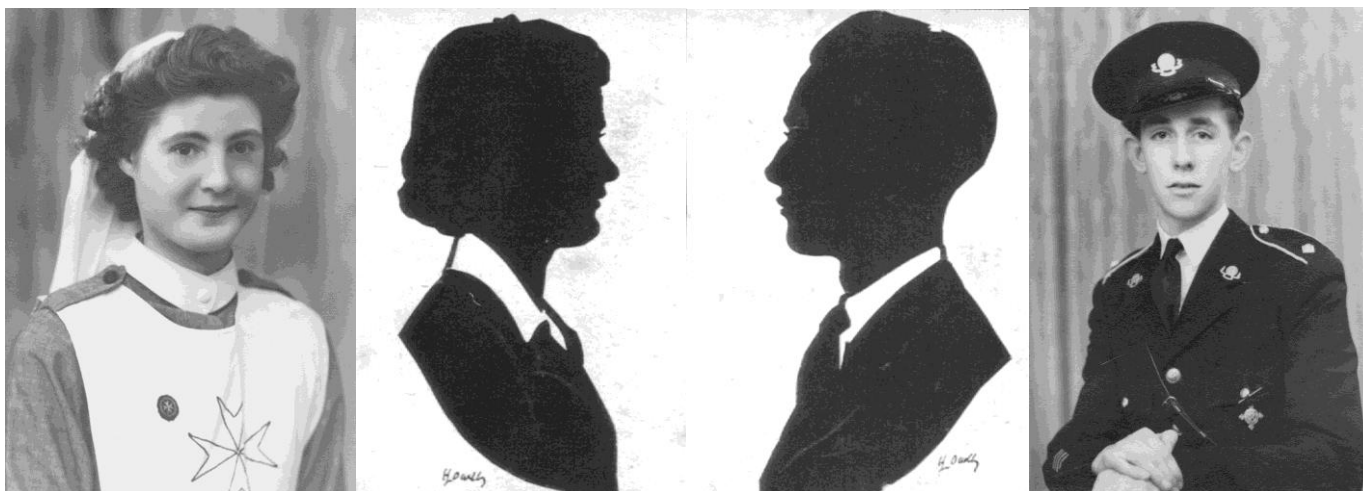

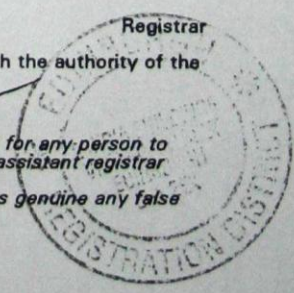

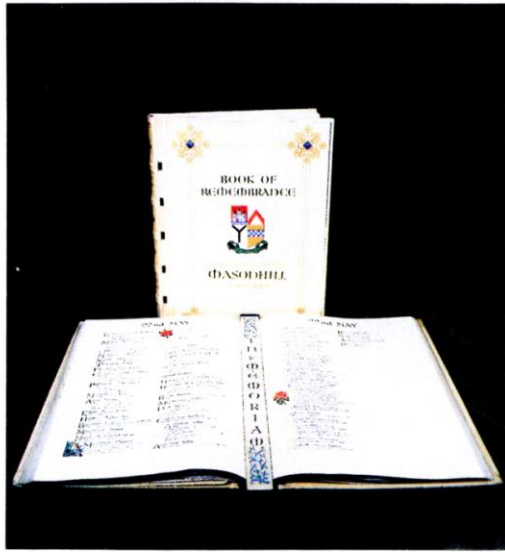
