We have details from the following certificates at New Register House in Edinburgh. Birth, marriage and death for Angus and Mary Wyse. Birth of Angus McP and death of James H. We have newspaper cuttings detailing :- Angus McP. death, Isa death, Doug & Amy marriage (ex silver wedding). We have certs. for Meg + Angus McP. birth & death, and Isa death. Isa, Doug and Mae birthdates by word of mouth ex Meg. We have a cremation certificate for Angus and a certificate granting burial rights to Angus Wyse at Ballengeich cemetery. Angus was chauffeur to the Shanks family, sanitary engineers, in Barrhead. Between 1906 and 1920's he was chauffeur to another family at Brentham Park, Stirling. About 1928 he was chauffeur to the Stewart family at Lochbrae House, Bearsden. He was a corporal in the Army Service Corps during WW1, serving as a lorry driver in Selonika & Egypt. Meg trained as a fever nurse and as a nursery nurse, was a nanny for 13 years, firstly to the Lang family in Paisley and then to the Low family in London. From 1944 to 1965 she worked in children's homes in Glasgow and was matron at Crosslees in Thornliebank, Glasgow for 16 years.

Angus McP, a railway engineer, worked in Swindon, Wiltshire, married Phyllis MILES and had Sarah-Ann (Sally) and a stillborn girl. Phyllis died after her 2<sup>nd</sup> childbirth. Angus then married Hilda Mary SMITH, no further children. We have copies of Phyllis' birth marriage & death certificates.

We have a transcribed copy of Mae's birth certificate. She emigrated to the USA when she was 19 in 1927. There she married her cousin Angus NICOL, and had 5 children. Isa was named after Mrs. Hutcheson of Netherton Farm, Barrhead where Angus and Mary were married. She trained as a nurse at Glasgow Western Infirmary and became a hospital matron at Hendon Isolation Hospital in London and at Castlehill Hospital in Hull. She retired to Abingdon in Oxfordshire to be near her niece Sally (family record B6.01). Doug trained with Babcocks then worked for Ferodo. He & Amy lived in Manchester and had 2 children : Jean McKenna and Malcolm Angus.
