John WRIGHT & Mary SCOTT identified ex son Henry's birth; John confirmed ex Henry & Edith's marriage. We have a copy of John's birth cert. which names both parents. Thomas WRIGHT confirmed as John's father and Robert Scott identified as Mary's father ex John & Mary's marriage certificate : neither John nor Mary could sign their name. John's baptism in 1847 (ex Internet IGI) gives father Thomas WRIGHT and mother Elizabeth. Elizabeth BRADBURY confirmed ex John's birth cert. Mary SCOTT's baptism in 1846 gives parents as Robert SCOTT and Charlotte (Internet IGI). Charlotte CLARK ex Chesterfield OPR marriages (Joan Smedley letter 02/07/1988). Mary SCOTT's birth record in Chesterfield OPR is probably Vol 19, page 556. Henry's details ex family 4. Details of other children initially by word of mouth from Audrey Wright / Vernie Birchmore. Charlotte to Ada birth years and places ex 1881 census. John & Annie WRIGHT had son John. Robert & Frances WRIGHT had 2 sons. Ada & Robert DEAN had Frederick & Robert. Emma & Harry DRAKE had Fred, Winnie, Maud & Harry. Henry's daughter Vernie Birchmore thought she remembered her grandfather (John WRIGHT) dying at Newton when she was aged 4 or 5. (i.e. c.1923) Vernie thought John WRIGHT & Mary SCOTT had c.12 children. (but Charlotte was born soon after marriage, and Mary was 40 when she had Henry, so this is unlikely)

1871 Census at Chapel St, Whittington, Derbyshire : John (coal miner) & Mary living with John's mother Elizabeth.
 1881 Census at 88 Newstead Colliery, Nottinghamshire : John (coal miner) & Mary living with 4 children.
 1891 Census at 20 Key St., Bulwell, Nottinghamshire : John (coal miner) & Mary living with 6 children.
 1901 Census at 7 Crown St., Bulwell, Nottinghamshire : John (coal miner) & Mary living with 3 children.
