Walter G. & Mary A. identified ex son John W. birth certificate, Walter G. ex John W. & E. Jane marriage. All birth dates + deaths of Walter G. & Mary A. ex Clamp Family Bible. Walter G. & Mary A. marriage date, parents and birthplaces ex copy of their marriage certificate. Walter G. baptism ex Shackerstone OPR (family group record 20). 1881 Nailstone census : at Main Street, Walter G. Ag. machinist, aged 25, born Sweptstone with wife Mary A., age 29 born Nailstone + son George A., aged 2, born Odstone. 1901 Measham census : at Tan Yard Cottages, High St., Walter G. (age 45, agricultural machiner), with wife Mary A. (age 49), George A. (age 22, engine driver traction), Walter W. (age 19, groom), Lucy M. (age 17), Mary A. (age 13), Gertrude (age 11), Annie E. (age 8), John W. (age 3). 1st 7 children born Odstone, John W. born Ibstock. Walter G & Mary A. lived at High St., Measham, then (after 1913) at Peggs Close, Measham (per Annie Winkless, Fam.Grp A3.06). Childrens' marriage partners and death dates ex Audrey Wright (d. of John W. & E.Jane) by word of mouth. George Alfred was re-married to Nancy DINGLE, presumably after Edith died. (ex Jean Morley). There is a gravestone at Snarestone of a George A. Clamp, which gives his widow as Annie. Nancy and Annie could be the same person. Annie CLAMP died 27/07/1972, aged 79. Mary A. CLAMP & Jesse DENNIS were married at Measham. We don't know when the family moved to Measham but WGC owned a small cycle shop in Measham by 1904.

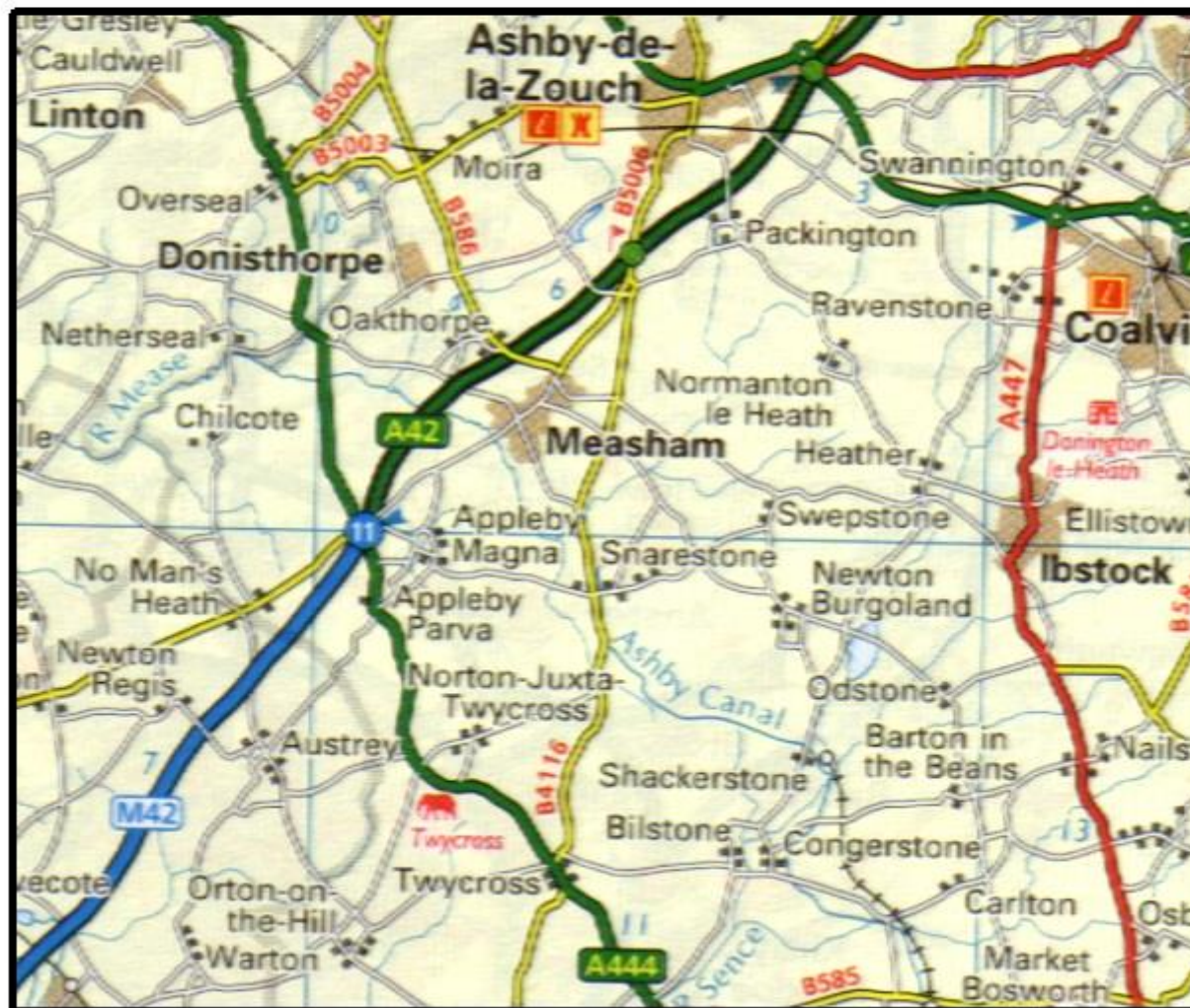
