Samuel & Mary Jane are identified ex daughter Esther Jane birth certificate, Samuel also identified ex Esther.Jane & John William CLAMP marriage certificate. We have copies of birth, marriage and death certificates of Samuel & Mary Jane. J Henry Coulton registered, and was present at, the death of both his parents.

Details of children and their marriage partners per Audrey WRIGHT (daughter of Esther Jane CLAMP) by word of mouth.

We have copies of birth, marriage and death certificates of Esther Jane COULTON and John William CLAMP.

We believe that both Samuel and Jane are interred in plot G12 of Nottingham Northern Cemetery at Bulwell. Walter was added to this plot 19-04-1949 (the date on the back of the burial certificate says 16-04-1949, so this could be either his death date or the approval date for use of the plot)

Christopher James WRIGHT, (ex family group 2), grandson of Esther Jane COULTON, was buried in the same plot with approval dated 14-05-1954.

John Henry buried 03-11-1954. (ex Penny Thornton, from Northern Cemetery records), but date on back of burial certificate is 10-11-1954.

Samuel jnr. ashes buried in urn in 1965 also in plot G12 (info. ex Mary OWEN, daughter of Esther Jane CLAMP)
