John & Mary identified ex marriage certificate & transcribed copies of birth and death certificates for Elizabeth. We have transcribed copies of their marriage and death certificates. These gave their ages when married and their parents names, which led to births and baptisms ex Chapel & Udney OPR's. John's death is also recorded in the Family Bible (of which we have a transcript)

William, Elizabeth, Archibald, Isabella, James & Mary birth years ex 'Scots ORIGINS'. Jean & William births ex internet IGI. We have a birth certificates for Archibald and transcribed birth certificates for Elizabeth, John, Isabella, James and Mary jnr. We have transcribed marriage certificates for Isabella Mary NICOL and Mary NICOL jnr

In 1871 Chapel census John Nicol was aged 33, farmer of 72 acres at Whitecross, and wife Mary (aged 20, born Udney) and also his mother Jean, widow aged 63 (born Oyne).

In 1881 John & Mary Nicol + family.were living at Cappernook, Chapel. This census identifies 1st 5 children. John snr was a farmer of 92 acres.

In 1891 Inch census : at Coldhome John 53, a grocer, Mary 40, William 18, Archibald 10, Isabella 8, James 6, Mary 3. James and Mary were born at Inch. Elizabeth (aged 16) was a domestic servant at Whitecross for John NICOL (her grandfather's brother). Jeannie & John jnr. were not at home.

In 1901 Kennethmont Census at Wardhead, John, aged 63, a crofter, with wife Mary, aged 50, and daughter Annie R Nicol aged 7 (born Inch). Elizabeth (aged 26) was a sick nurse living in Castle Douglas. John jnr was a 23 year old ploughman at Templand, Culsalmond

John NICOL jnr death date ex Ann Sutherland & Betty Robertson.

Annie & James BARRON both died in Canada. James M. NICOL died in Excelsior, Missouri (photo of gravestone online).

Jean & James McKELVEY were married in Belfast. Jeannie died in Belfast in 1940. (Copy of certificate online)



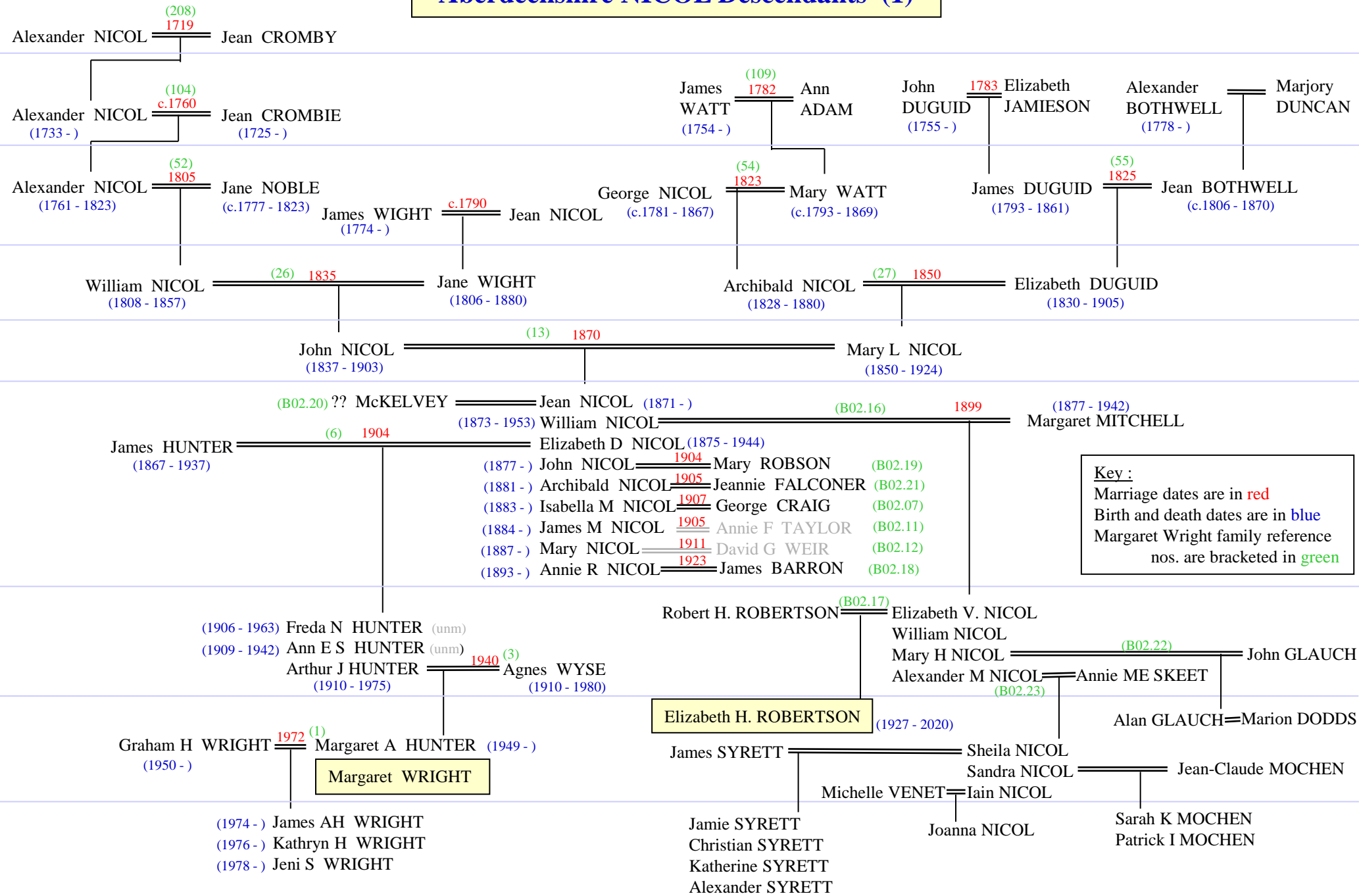

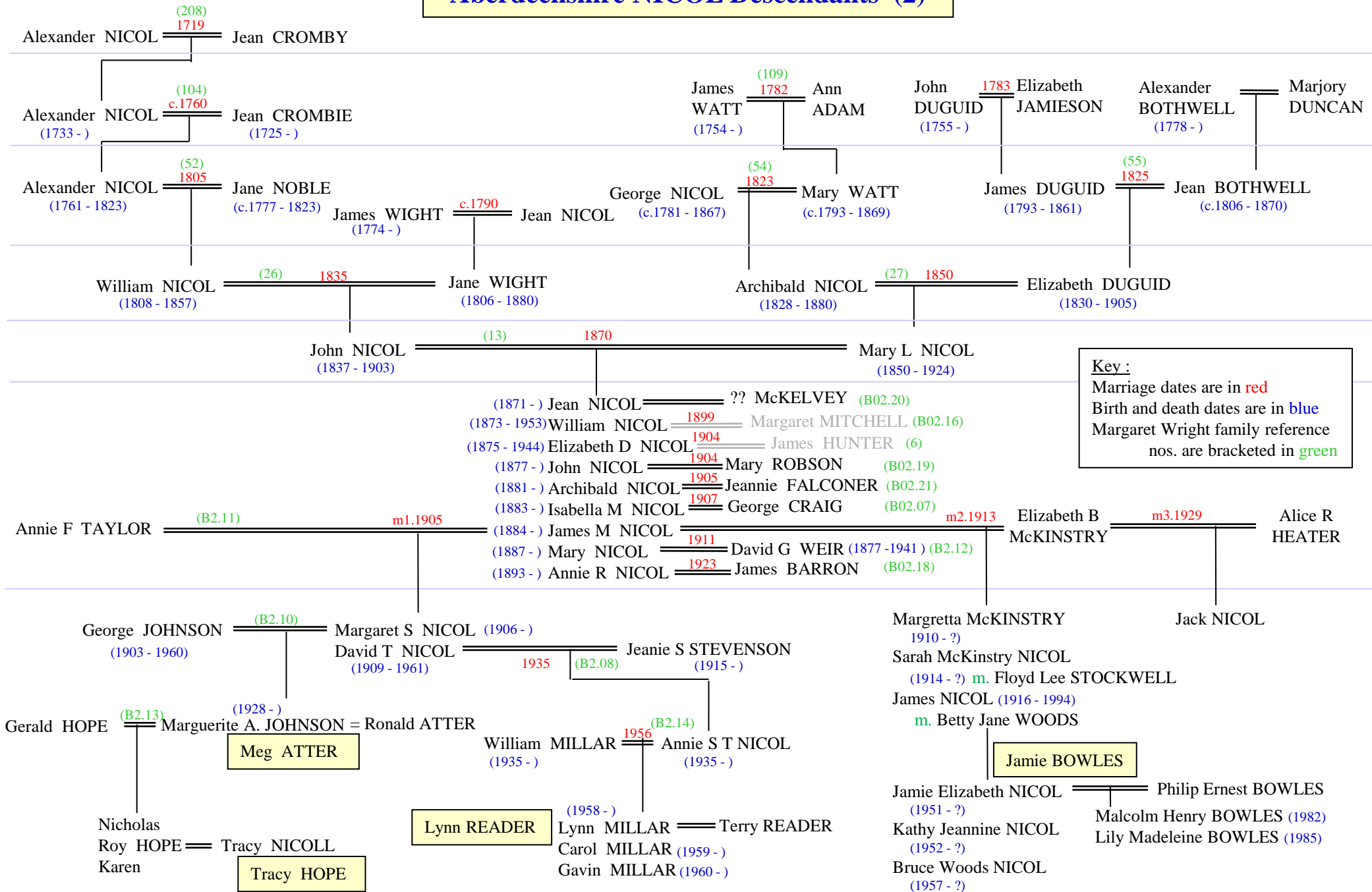

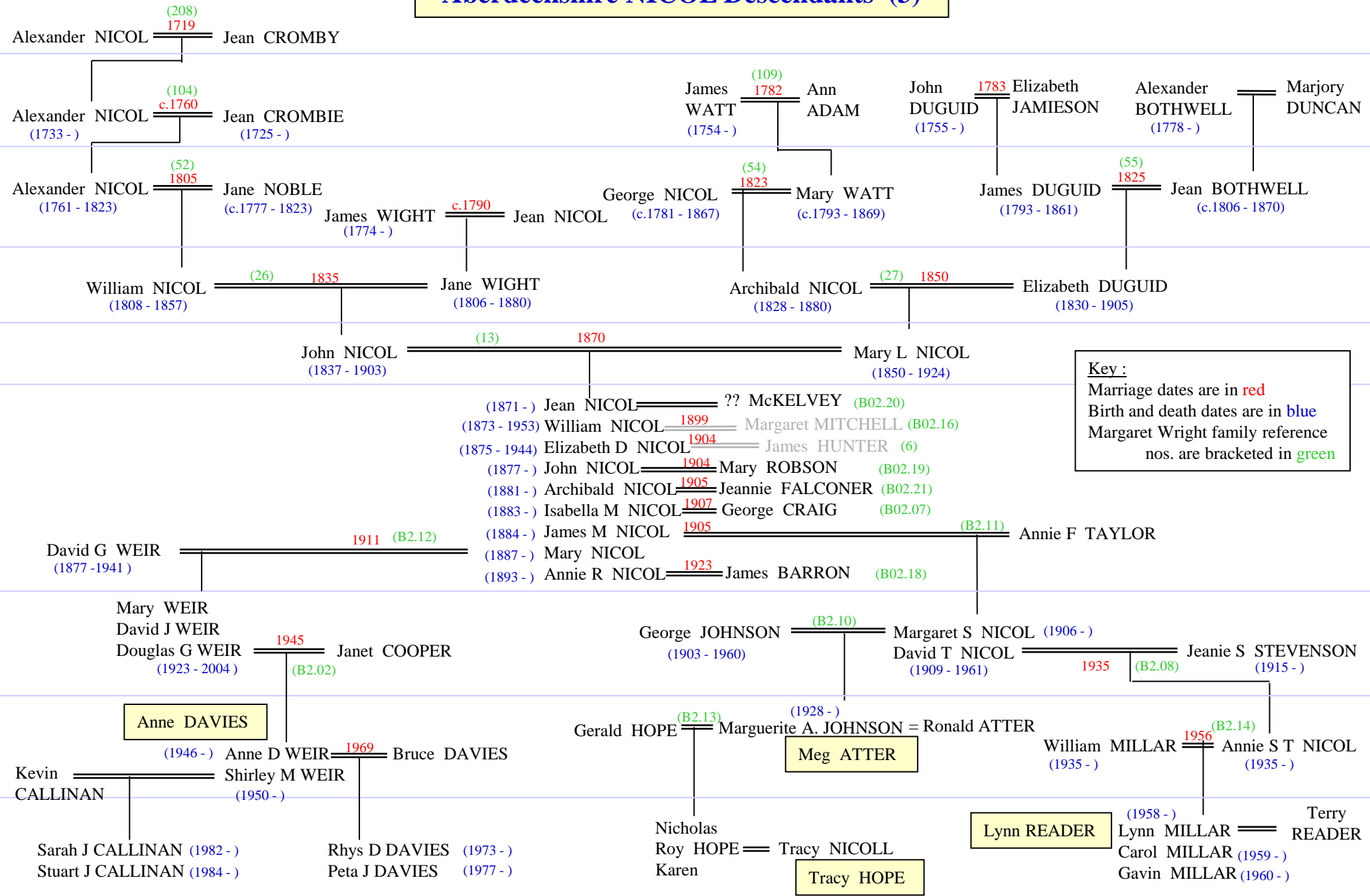

Children's Marriages

We have a photocopy of correspondence to a Mrs Weir (probably Jeannie's sister Mary) from a [step-]son and a [step-] daughter of Jeannie who signed the letter as Edith McKelvey and H McKelvey. We are told (by Betty Robertson) that **Jeannie's** married name was **McKelvey** and she and her husband lived in Northern Ireland, and indeed the above letters were written in N.Ireland. The fact that the letters are addressed to Mrs Weir and not aunt or auntie, suggests that they were not Jeannie's children and that they were from her husband's previous marriage.

Betty Robertson remembers her grandfather, William NICOL, talking about going to his sister Jeannie's wedding at the Caledonian Hotel in Edinburgh. We searched "Scotlands People" for marriages of a Jean NICOL in Edinburgh as follows and found 5, none of which was to a McKelvey. So maybe she was married in Northern Ireland and had a reception in Edinburgh.
