

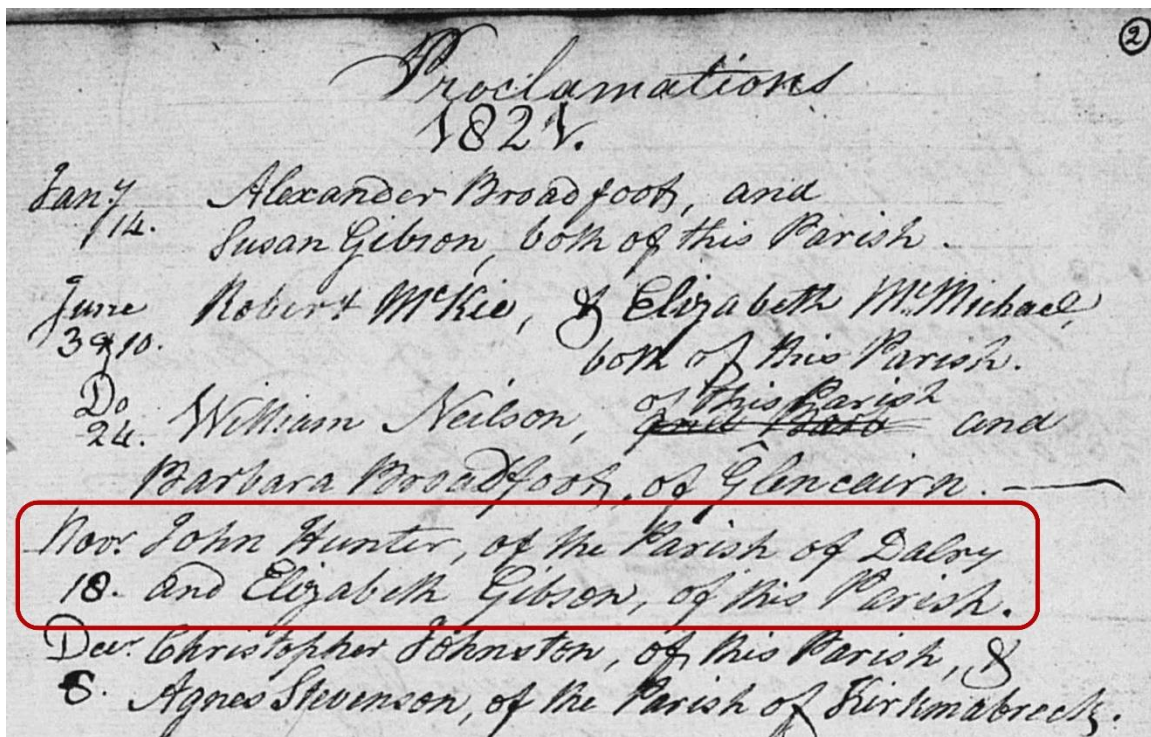

John HUNTER and Elizabeth GIBSON are great-great grandparents of Margaret WRIGHT (née HUNTER).  
 We know of John & Elizabeth from the Hunter family bible and from Samuel's marriage and death certificates. We have a copy of both death certificates.  
 The death certificates are the only source of their parents' names. Ages at death suggests John & Elizabeth each born c. 1798.  
 John's age in 1841, 1851 & 1861 census is 40, 51 & 62, whilst Elizabeth was 40, 48 & 62. Marriage of John & Elizabeth came from the IGI. Marion baptism ex Balmaclellan OPR.  
 There are 5 John Hunter's, son of James, christened in Scotland between 1795 and 1800 per Scots ORIGINS, but none near Dalry, or with anything like correct mother's name.  
 No birth/christening of Elizabeth to a Samuel Gibson anywhere in Scotland from 1797 to 1807 per Scots ORIGINS. There is a Samuel Gibson chr. in 1774 at Glencairn (also 1761)  
 We have seen birth entries in the Dalry OPR for John (jnr) and Margaret. Marriages of Marion, James and John ex internet IGI. Marian's baptism confirmed in OPR  
 The Dalry records were mislaid for many years and restarted in 1839, so we have found little OPR reference to this family. Records appear to be missing between about 1776 and 1827.  
 In 1841 Dalry census, John & Elizabeth were living with children Elizabeth, Isobella, Samuel, John & Grace. 1851 Mary was a maid near Bogue. Marion lived near Dalry with her family.  
 In 1851 Dalry census, John & Elizabeth were living with children James, Isabella, John, Grace & Margaret. John & Elizabeth (snr.) born in Dalry & Parton respectively  
 In 1861 Dalry census, John & Elizabeth were living with children Mary, Isabella, John & also grandson John age 9 and James Gray, grandson aged 6. J & E born Dalry & Parton.  
 In 1881 Dalry census, Elisabeth HUNTER, widow, aged 80, living at Halfmark with daughter Mary aged 53 and grandson John aged 29, a stone dyker.
