We know that William NICOL & Jane WIGHT are the parents of John NICOL from John's marriage certificate in 1870, and that William was deceased at this time. We also identify William & Jean from the birth of their only son John in 1837 according to the Chapel OPR.

We found the marriage of William & Jane in the Chapel OPR, which gives the full marriage date in 1835.

In 1841 Chapel census William was a farmer aged 30, living at Little Whitecross with Jean aged 30 and John aged 3

In 1851 Chapel census William was a farmer of 110 acres (with his brother) aged 42 living at Little Whitecross with Jean aged 43, John aged 13 + 2 servants

In 1861 Chapel census John aged 23 was a farmer of 52 acres at Whitecross living with widowed mother Jane aged 52

Jean was living at (Little) Whitecross, Chapel with William in the 1841 & 1851 censuses but was widowed in 1861. Knowing this we get William's death at Whitecross in 1857, and this in turn gives his parents names which again help to confirm William's birth ex IGI. Jane's death (given both married & maiden surnames) in 1880 gives her parents names. William baptism ex Scots ORIGINS, Jane birth ex Aberdeenshire IGI. John's birth ex Chapel OPR. John was probably an only child (see gravestone inscription)

Didn't find John or Jane in (handwritten) Chapel census for 1871. [was possibly at Cappernook in 1871, as his 1st child Elizabeth born there 1875 and mother Jane died there 1880]

We have transcribed copies of death certificates for both William and Jane. Photograph of gravestone at Chapel.

William's brother John was witness on his death certificate. Jane's death certificate was witnessed by son John.

Why was there only 1 child ? Could it be that William was Rh+, Jane was Rh- and then **if** John was born Rh+ , Jane would probably miscarry all subsequent Rh+ children.

There is Rh- in at least one offspring line, i.e. Margaret HUNTER (Family 01), g-g grand-daughter of the above William and Jane. (i.e. John would have carried Rh+ and Rh- blood)
