William Clark, framework knitter, was identified from Charlotte's marriage to Robert Scott in 1841. Charlotte was a minor (i.e. under 21). Marriage was only 5 months before Charlotte gave birth to her 1st child.

The only Charlotte CLARK born to a William CLARK in Chesterfield between 1820 and 1830 has parents William and Bessey, dated 14-03-1825, and William was a framework knitter. The only appropriate marriage for William per internet IGI is to Elizabeth SIDDALL in 1816, confirmed by Joan Smedley in the OPR, which stated that both parties were from Brampton. Hannah, Emma and Henry were born to William (framework knitter) and Elizabeth (or Bessy) in Chesterfield, so they probably belong to the same family as Charlotte.

1841 Chesterfield census at Spread Eagle Y^d: William Clark aged 45, cotton lace maker, with Elizabeth (43), Hannah (18), Charlotte (16), William (13, cotton lace maker), Emma (11), Henry (9), Charles (7), Elizabeth (5) & Mary (1)

1851 Chesterfield census : a William Clark aged 55, a twisthand and widower, born Brampton, was living with Henry (19), Elizabeth (16), Mary (11), Ann (6), George (3), + Alfred GREGORY son-in-law, all born Chesterfield. IGI confirms that Alfred GREGORY's mother was Elizabeth (unmarried).
