Samuel & Elizabeth are identified ex Elizabeth jnr. death certificate. We have not found the birth of Elizabeth jnr or a marriage of Samuel & Elizabeth. In the 1851 & 1861 Dalry censuses Elizabeth jnr. was married to John Hunter, and gave her place of birth as Parton We know Elizabeth jnr. was born around 1798 because she died aged 88 in 1886. Clearly with nothing else to go on, it is difficult to conclude anything more of substance, but it is worthy of note that a Samuel GIBSON was born to John GIBSON and Mary GRIER at Glencairn on 29-04-1774, which is the right sort of age and place relative to Elizabeth jnr's birth date. Although Elizabeth's maiden surname was transcribed as COUGHTESSON it appears likely that the name could be OUGHTERSON, and there is evidence of this surname in Dumfriesshire. The only marriage of a Samuel Gibson to an Elizabeth between 1760 and 1800 anywhere in Scotland was the wrong surname and in Arbroath. The only children born to a Samuel Gibson married to an Elizabeth between 1770 and 1810 were 2 children of the couple in Arbroath. On the 1853 map of Kirkcudbrightshire, a lint mill is marked (grid ref. 663742). It is just off the A713 Castle Douglas to Ayr road, near Shirmers Bridge, north of Parton Village.
