James WIGHT and Jean NICOL identified ex Jane NICOL (née WIGHT) death certificate. Jane died aged 72 in 1880, which suggests birth between March 1807 and March 1808. All children's christenings ex Scots ORIGINS, but only the father name was given (i.e. James WIGHT), so relevance of all depends on Jean's christening being the correct one. Online IGI only gives George WIGHT under children of James WIGHT and Jean NICOL. No evidence of James WIGHT & Jean NICOL marriage. No evidence of them in 1841 per FreeCEN. William's possible marriage ex ORIGINS.

1861 Chapel census : at Whitecross, John NICOL (family 26) age 23 unmarried farmer, born Chapel, with mother Jane NICOL a widow age 52, born Oyne

Marriage of James Wight & Jean Nicol

Jean Wight who married William Nicol, died in 1880 aged 72, so would have been born about 1807. Her death certificate names her parents as James Wight & Jean Nicol.
