We could not find a marriage of George jnr. & Agnes McPherson in Scots ORIGINS, but we know their 1st child Christian Wyce was born in 1821 at Cadder. This George Wyse died in 1846 age 55, suggesting his birth was around 1790. George Wise & Jean Findlay were married in 1776 in Glasgow, and their 9 children are all in Scots ORIGINS. We have a transcript of marriage details from the Glasgow OPR, and also a record of the birth of a son (no name given) on 3/10/1789 (i.e. George Archibald)

The only George Wyse birth in Scotland after 1716 but before 1776 was a son of James Wyse and Agnes Dunsmoor. He was baptised on 12-07-1761 at Barony. If the baptism of this George took place soon after his birth, then he would be only 15 at the time of the marriage to Jean Findlay in 1776. This can only realistically be the correct George (and hence give the correct parents) if he was at least 2 or 3 yrs old when he was christened. [N.B. an older brother, William, was christened on 02-09-1759] It is likely therefore that the birth of the correct George Wyse does not exist in Scots ORIGINS (i.e. has not been recorded or the parish records have been lost).
