We have a copy of a filiation order dated 18-10-1799 in which Elizabeth CLAMP of Shackerstone charges William BOWN of Bagworth Park as being the father of the child she was carrying. Rebackah was baptised as Elizabeth's daughter on 12-01-1800.

Lewis Davenport searched the Shackerstone OPR in 1982 and found Rebackah, Thomas and Sarah all baptised children of the unmarried Elizabeth CLAMP.

Also in the Shackerstone OPR were baptism dates for Jonathan, Martha, Joseph and Samuel.

1841 Shackerstone census : Elizabeth WILLSON aged 60 + Joseph (25), Ann (20), Samuel (15), Elizabeth(10), William (8). All were born in Leics. [N.B. Elizabeth & William were grandchildren, offspring of Sarah CUTHBERT (née CLAMP)

1851 Shackerstone census : Elizabeth WILSON (73, washerwoman) + Joseph (28, Ag. Lab.), Ann (26, Lace Runner) & Samuel (24, Ag. Lab.). All born Shackerstone.
