N.B. Alexander jnr was said to be born on fornication per Inverurie OPR, but there is no sign of this in the IGI, nor is there a marriage record for Alexander Nicol & Jean Crombie.

There are 4 James Cromby (or Crombie) marriages in Aberdeenshire between 1690 and 1730. The marriage to Margaret NICOL was in 1718 and is the nearest to the christening date of Jean CROMBIE (but we don't know of any of Jean's siblings).

If Jean's mother was Margaret NICOL, note the inter-relationship between Nicol's and Crombie's in the parents names.
