Christening of Joseph BRIGGS gives parents George & Jane BRIGGS. The above marriage is the only IGI marriage of a George BRIGGS to a Jane anywhere in England between 1742 and 1782, and the date fits with the birth of their first child. 1st 3 children are the only children of George & Jane BRIGGS in England bet. 1757 and 1777 per the IGI It is likely that Jane died somewhere between George (jnr) birth in 1764 and 1779 when George (snr) seems to have re-married to Lidia HORSLEY. We are aware of no other George BRIGGS in Denby of a suitable age to marry in 1779.

Gill WARRIS has provided, via GenesReunited, her assumption that George BRIGGS snr did marry Lidia HORSLEY and that they had 8 children between 1769 and 1793. Some of Lidia's children were christened at Denby, and some were christened at Ripley Pentrich Non-Conformist Church.

Can we believe that (a) Jane died or split up with George, (b) George and Lydia met and had their first child when George was 34 and Lydia might have been about 20, (c) they then lived together for 10 years, having 3 children before they married in 1779 and (c) would George have named his 7<sup>th</sup> & 8th children after his 2<sup>nd</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> children by Jane WOOD (albeit that we know that at least the 1st Samuel died young)?
