We know of Thomas HUNTER snr. from Lilian Pickard. He is her direct descendant. His death certificate confirms his wife's name and parents' names. Most information apart from 1851 & 1881 Census is from Lilian Pickard. We have a photo of the gravestone at Carsphairn 1851 Carsphairn Census, at Lagwine, (*Liggate?*) Thomas HUNTER, labourer, (aged 44, born Dalry) with wife Elizabeth (aged 39, born Carsphairn) and children Isabella, employed at home (aged 16), James, (aged 10), John (aged 8), Thomas (aged 6) and Adam (aged 4). All the children were born in Carsphairn. Also in 1851 Carsphairn Census Margaret HUNTER (aged 12, born Carsphairn) living with her grandmother Catherine GOOD (a widow, aged 69, born Dalry). She was a pauper + son John GOOD, labourer, (a widower aged 42, born Carsphairn) and his sons James (aged 8) and Robert (aged 5), both born Carsphairn. And at Carsphairn Village, at home of Kirkpatrick GRACIE, tailor, William HUNTER, unmarried, a tailor's apprentice, (aged 17, born Carsphairn) William & Ann HUNTER had Jane (b. 1856), Elizabeth G. (b. 1857), John (b. 1859), Thomas (b. 1861) & William (b. 1867). Ann WELSH was born in 1830 & died 1908 Isabella had 2 children – Margaret (1858) & Thomas (1867), both reputed to have father ?? HALLIDAY. In June 1863 Margaret's birth cert. changed to show surname HALLIDAY James & Elizabeth HUNTER had Agnes C. (b.c.1865, Elizabeth (b. c. 1868), Isabella (b.c.1872) & Rosy (b. c. 1874). Elizabeth MILLIGAN (b.1840 – d.1914) Adam & Mary HUNTER had a son George (b. c. 1875 Carsphairn) in 1881 Census. Mary was born c. 1852 at Keir Dumfriesshire

- 3 Thomas, born in Dalry, about 1807, and married to Elizabeth Good, who had been born in Carsphairn on 30th August 1811. At the time of the 1841 Census, Elizabeth was living at Langwine, Carsphairn, with four children, but her husband was not at home. Thomas, described as a labourer with his wife and five children at the time of the 1851 Census, and the retired couple were living alone in Carsphairn Village at the time of the 1881 Census. Elizabeth died in Carsphairn on 6th July 1884 and Thomas died there on 17th October 1887. Their children were :-
- a. William, born in Carsphairn on 28th December 1833, and married in Buittle on 11th May 1855 to Ann Welsh, who had been born in Buittle on 6th January 1829, the daughter of Edward Welsh, a labourer, and his wife Mary Alexander. At the time of the 1871 Census, the couple were living in Carsphairn Village, where William was described as a labourer, with three children. William died in Carsphairn on 29th December 1880 and Ann lived there until her death on 24th January 1908. Their children were
 - i. Jane, born in Buittle on 21st March 1856, and married in Carsphairn on 11th June 1880 to Samuel Murray, a baker, who had been born in Maxwelltown about 1858, the son of Samuel Murray, a soldier, and his wife Jane Glendinning. At the time of the 1881 Census, the couple were living with Jane's mother in Carsphairn, by 1891 they were living in Melrose, and in the 1901 Census Jane and children were still living in Melrose, but Samuel was lodging in a hotel in Duns. No trace can be found of this couple or their children in the Scottish registration records after the 1901 Census. Their children were :-
 - A. Jane Glendinning, born in Dumfries on 23rd April 1883
 - B. Annie Welsh, born in Dumfries on 13th January 1885
 - C. Randolph, born in Dumfries on 31st March 1887
 - D. Elizabeth Hunter, born in Dumfries on 3rd February 1890
 - E. Marion Riddick, born in Melrose on 24th May 1892
 - ii. Elizabeth Good, born in Buittle on 10th April 1857. and died unmarried, in the Crichton Royal Institution, Dumfries, on 19th June 1923. She had a son
 - A. William, surname Hunter, born in Carsphairn on 18th February 1883 and died there on 17th October 1897, from meningitis, when he was described as a grocer's apprentice.
 - iii. John, born in Crossmichael on 26th July 1859 and died in Carsphairn on 19th October 1879.
 - iv. Thomas, born in Carsphairn on 14th October 1861, and died there on 9th November 1880.
 - v. William, born in Carsphairn on 13th October 1867, and died there on 1st July 1877.
 - b. Isabella, born about 1835, and died unmarried in Carsphairn on 31st March 1872. She had a son
 - i. Thomas, born in Carsphairn on 6th January 1867, and included with his mother in his grandparents' household in the 1871 Census. Thomas was married in Dalry on 24th February 1888 to Marion Gerrand Bryden, who had been born in Dalry on 27th July 1870, the daughter of Margaret Bryden, a farm servant. Marion died in Dalmellington on 16th March 1932, and Thomas died there on 13th October 1935. Their children were :-
 - A. Sarah Bryden, born in Dalmellington on 2nd July 1893.
 - B. Isabella, born in Dalmellington on 12th May 1895.
 - C. John, born in Dalmellington on 16th July 1896 and died on 17th.
 - O. John Bryden, born in Dalmellington on 10th March 1898.
 - E. Annie Welsh, born in Dalmellington on 29th August 1900.
 - F. Jeanie Pettigrew, born in Dalmellington on 10th December 1901.
 - G. Maggie Bryden, born in Dalmellington on 4th March 1903.
 - H. Thomas. born in Dalmellington on 14th December 1905, and died a week later on the 22nd.
 - I. Thomas, born in Dalmellington on 4th August 1908, and died on 27th June 2001
 - c. Margaret, born about 1837, and married in Carsphairn on 9th December 1859 to Robert Bumet, who had been born about 1830, the son of David Bumet, a labourer, and his wife Susan Twedie.
 - d. James, born in Carsphairn about 1840, and married in Kirkgunzeon on 29th December 1876 to Elizabeth Milligan, who had been born in Balmaghie about 1851, the daughter of William Milligan, a ploughman, and his wife Agnes McIntire. Elizabeth died in Carsphairn on 10th February 1905 and James died there on 3rd September 1914. Their children were :-
 - i. Agnes Crockett, born in Kirkgunzeon on 26th May 1877, and married in Carsphairn on 27th November 1896 to Alexander McHenry, a ploughman, who had been born about 1874, the son of William McHenry, a mariner, and his wife Jane Ireland. Agnes died at Kirkgunzeon on 8th July 1897 from pneumonia, at the age of 20. Her gravestone in Carsphairn kirkyard was erected by her husband and her father. Alexander died in Rhonehouse on 21st September 1941. They had a daughter :

- A. Jemima Hunter, born in Carsphairn on 24th January 1897 and died there on 22nd May 1899.
- ii. Elizabeth, born in Kirkgunzeon on 26th May 1871, and married in Carsphairn on 10th July 1896 to Robert Litterick, a quarryman. who had been born about 1874, the son of Robert Litterick, a tanner, and his wife Agnes Law.
 - iii. Isabella, born in Carsphairn on 8th December 1880.
 - iv. Rose Ann Welsh, born in Carsphairn on 16th December 1885, and married there on 24th June 1910 to Andrew Laurie, who had been born about 1875, the son of Thomas Laurie, a farmer, and his wife Catherine Maxwell. At the time of their marriage, Rosie was a Dalrymaid and Andrew was a farmer, of Brockhillstone, Dunscore.
- e. John, born in Carsphairn about 1842, and married in Dalmellington on 11th December 1874 to Sarah McLean, who had been born in Dalmellington about 1852, the daughter of Thomas McLean, a gardener and his wife Agnes McNab. Sarah died in Carsphairn on 23rd August 1920, and John died there on 6th February 1933. Their children were :-
- i. Thomas, born in Carsphairn on 15th September 1875. Thomas was the informant on his father's death in 1933, at which time his address was in Maidstone, Kent.
 - ii. Agnes McNab, born in Carsphairn on 20th December 1876, and died, unmarried, in Glasgow on 2nd November 1953.
 - iii. Elizabeth Good, born in Carsphairn on 4th July 1878, and married in Carsphairn on 30th December 1904 to James Campbell, who had been born about 1882, the son of John Campbell, described as a contractor for estate work, and his wife Agnes Campbell. Elizabeth died at East Lodge, Cassillis, Kirkmichael on 15th December 1937.
 - iv. Adam, born in Carsphairn on 4th April 1880. and married in Ayr on 3rd June 1904 to Jeanie Garrett Paton Glencross, who had been born about 1878, the daughter of John Glencross, a railway lorryman, and his wife Mary Paton. Jeanie died in Ayr on 12th June 1922, and Adam died there on 8th October 1951, when he was described as a retired master fruiterer.
 - v. Anne Welsh, born in Carsphairn on 27th February 1882, and married in Carsphairn on 2nd June 1905 to Quintin Currie, a gardener, who had been born about 1879, the son of David Currie, a ploughman, and his wife Jeanie Logan. Quintin died in Kirkoswald on 22nd July 1930, when he was described as a railway porter, and Annie there on 18th June 1955.
 - vi. Ellen, born in Carsphairn on 19th May 1884.
 - vii. Marion, known as May, born in Carsphairn on 27th June 1887, and married in Carsphairn on 7th June 1911 to John Pickup Ashworth, a coachman, then living in Paisley, who had been born about 1881, the son of John Ashworth, an innkeeper, and his wife Sarah Jane Ramsbottom.
 - viii. Georgina, born in Carsphairn on 30th March 1889, and married there on 20th August 1913 to Hugh Wood, who had been born about 1887, the son of James Wood, a miner, and his wife Elizabeth Muir. At the time of their marriage, Georgina was a domestic servant and Hugh was a police constable.
 - ix. Margaret, born in Carsphairn on 27th September 1890 and died there on 30th April 1892
 - x. Jane, born in Carsphairn on 30th May 1892 and died there, 5 weeks later, on 5th July.
 - xi. Catherine, born in Carsphairn on 14th July 1893
 - xii. Sarah, born in Carsphairn on 30th October 1895, and died there on 17th January 1897.
