

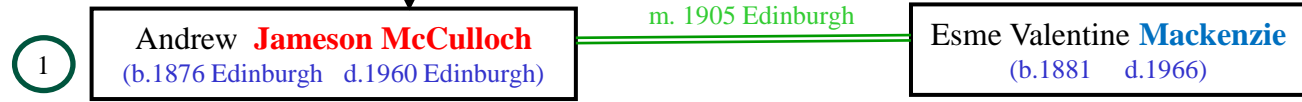


Judge Lord Ardwall
Son of Sherrif Andrew Jameson, of Edinburgh

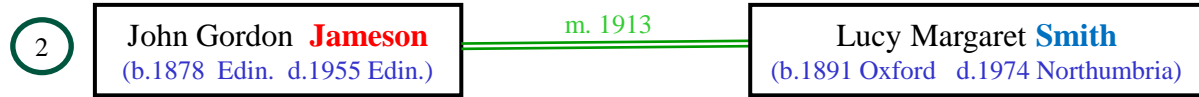
Lady Ardwall

JAMESON family of Ardwall



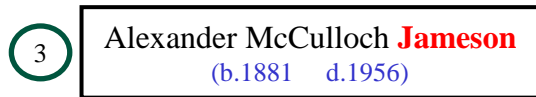
Inherited Ardwall in 1940 on the death of his mother



John Gordon was a soldier during the Boer War, and was a major in WW1. He was badly injured in 1917. He became an advocate and barrister before becoming MP for West Edinburgh. He and Lucy had 3 children

- Andrew John **Jameson** b.1916 Oxford d.1934 Edinburgh
- Alexa **Jameson** b.1919 Edinburgh

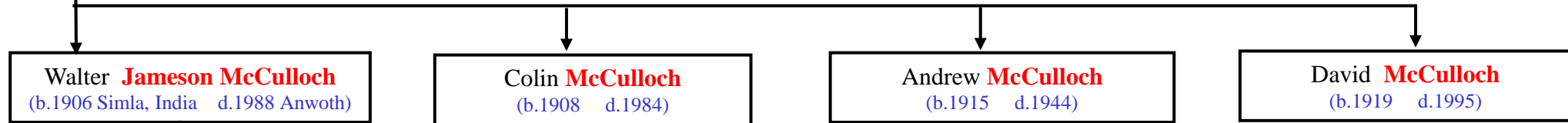
Andrew John died of sepsis in 1934, after which his mother published a book telling the story of his 18 years.



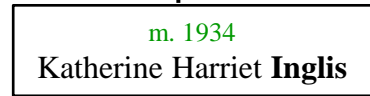
Lived at Gaitgil
