Peter & Eliza Jardine : children of Thomas Jardine & Ann Ellen Drummond



Eliza Ann Gilbert Drummond Jardine was born on 19th July 1883 at High Street, Gatehouse. She was known by her family and friends as 'Lizzie' and she married James McLean Anderson in 1920 at Paisley. *Date on photo 1922.*



Peter Drummond Jardine (standing to the side of SW88) was born on 3rd April 1882 at High Street, Gatehouse to Thomas Jardine (Plumber) and Ann Ellen Jardine née Drummond. He married Agnes Ireland Straiton on 18th June 1914 at Gatehouse. This was the first car that Peter owned. Peter was 'car mad' and he owned many different makes, including Vauxhall, Hillman, Minx (all models of the time). Peter ran the Brewery garage with petrol pumps in the 1930s. The car was registered in Kirkcudbright.

Thomas & Ann were married in 1880 in the Parish of Morton.
