

## 67 & 69 High Street – The Wine House



*69 & 67 High Street*

Nos. 67 & 69 High Street existed under single ownership until no.69 was sold separately in the 1920s.

#### Nos. 67 & 69 High Street

- 1771** William Riddick of Corbieton started to pay feu duty on the Wine House.
- 1788** Feu to William Riddick of Corbieton.
- 1789** Sold to Rev William Patterson.
- 1802** Sold to John McWilliam, merchant, Gatehouse. John McWilliam was a partner in Scott's Mill.
- 1812** Sold to Thomas Wright, tanner.
- 1813** Sold to Samuel McClellan.

**1852**      Alexander McClellan, farmer, Quarterland borrowed £50 on the property from William Cormick

**1859 Valuation Roll :**    Mrs Mary McLellan owned 2 properties, each described as house & garden (part). *It is possible that these properties could be 67 & 69 High Street.* Alexander McLellan, gamedealer, occupied one property (no.69), and Thomas McCreadie lived in the other (no.67).

**1878 Valuation Roll :**    John McClellan, of Australia, owned 2 properties, one described as house & garden and the other simply as a house. Alexander McClellan, gamedealer, occupied the house & garden, and Mrs Agnes Carter lived in the other house.

**1884 Valuation Roll :**    John McClellan, of Australia, still owned 2 rentable properties. The house without garden was still occupied by Mrs Agnes Carter. The other property, a house & garden, occupied by Alexander McClellan, gamedealer was identified as part of Laurelbank. Messrs Helme and Broadfoot occupied the other Laurelbank properties. *We believe there were only 2 properties at*

*Laurelbank and so there must be a transcription error – Alexander McClellan is still living at 69 High Street..*

**1974** Charles and Margaret Holditch sold to Charles and Jennifer Gillespie

**1976** Sold by Charles Gillespie to Anthony Snook and Valerie Mushet

**1979** Sold by Anthony Snook and Valerie Mushet.
