Neilson Square	G			Named after William Neilson. William was born in Balmaghie but emigrated to Canada to work with his brother where he made some money. He returned to Gatehouse c.1798 and used some of his money to build Neilson Square. A plaque on building says A.D.1812 A large building with further housing was built behind the terrace and known as <b>Back Neilson</b> . This may have been included in Neilson Square in some census and valuation rolls. In 1881 census the whole area was called Rosebank.	Part of Ann Street
Nelson Street		Neilson Square		Reference in 1853 of animal knocking down a lamp post. ( <i>Russell</i> ) Pigot's directory of 1825/26 also calls the area Nelsion Street. Erroneous spelling of Neilson Square – even in Valuation Rolls.	
<i>Nether</i>				Anglo saxon neðra = lower. ( <i>Maxwell</i> ). As in Nether Rusko.
