Plate 9 was registered on 9th November 1840 and its earlist known use is 18th November. In the original unrepaired state of the plate every stamp from plate9 showed stage 2 of the "o" flaw.

Flate 9 was in use long after red printing from other black plates had finished. It is by no means unusual to find red stamps from this plate bearing 1843 (number in cross) cancellations and these stamps have colour and appearance of printing from plates of this period.

Flate 9, Frinted in Red (2 repair) or state 2 repaired 1841 Flate 9 printed in Red later, which was only printed in red was known as state 8 in letter groups of AC — AJ and also EC.
