## Cox's Lodge: The Lock-up

"The house at the gate, leading into Cally by way of Nelson Square, is locally known as the Lock Up from the fact that at one time it was used as a place of detention and punishment for evildoers. It was built by Alexander Murray Esq. of Cally and Broughton, and the upper part consisted of two small apartments without chimneys, each lighted by two small windows near the ceiling and having stone floors. For slight offences, the culprits were incarcerated for twenty four hours in those apartments, but in serious cases accused were detained until handed over to the county police. A night in the cells was characterised by the inhabitants as a night among the Isle of Man blankets, the reason being that the flags came from that island."

## **◄** Chronology of Ownership & Occupancy ►

At the top of Ann Street next to the gates leading into Cally Estate was the "lock up" built by Alexander Murray at his own expense about 1828 and used for housing petty offenders for short periods. It remained part of Cally Estate until the twentieth century. It was the 'Cally Porter's Lodge' for many years before becoming the home of gardener Bert Cox, who laid out and tended the garden at Cushat Wood. The modern references to Cox's Lodge is in memory of Bert Cox.
