

19 Birtwhistle Street

From the time they were built (in 17xx) until 1947, all the properties on the north side of Birtwhistle Street were under single ownership. The owner did change from time to time, but ownership covered all the houses on that side of the street.

The censuses alone do not provide sufficient information to be sure of who lived in what house before the 1881 census.

Ownership up to 1947 is contained in a separate file ("Birtwhistle St.N to 1947"), and all recorded occupants of Birtwhistle Street in the first 4 censuses are also listed separately ("Birtwhistle St.N census 1841" to Birtwhistle St.N census 1871")..

1911-12 Valuation Roll :

James Dalrymple owned all the houses on the north side of Birtwhistle Street. The tenant of No.19 was William Shaw, labourer.

1921-22 Valuation Roll :

James Dalrymple owned all the houses on the north side of Birtwhistle Street. The tenant of No.19 was William Hay, labourer.

1930-31 Valuation Roll :

All the houses on the north side of Birtwhistle Street are owned by James Dalrymple, Glasgow. No.19 is occupied by Henry Patterson.

1940-41 Valuation Roll :

All the houses on the north side of Birtwhistle Street except East View are owned by John & Catherine Miller. No.19 is occupied by Norman Muir, grocer.

1950-51 Valuation Roll :

House numbers 3 to 21 Birtwhistle Street (except 15) are all owned by James B Clark, Clauchan. No.19 is occupied by Norman Muir, insurance agent.

1960-61 Valuation Roll :

19 Birtwhistle Street is owned by Mrs Elizabeth Murray-Usher, Cally Estate Office, and is occupied by J Lennox.

1974-75 Valuation Roll :

19 Birtwhistle Street is owned and occupied by Mrs Agnes D Adamson.
