We are fairly sure that Archibald Pickthall lived at no.18 and Robert Bennett had a large enough family to require a house the size of no.22. There are 2 entries in the census which suggests 2 buildings in between these 2 properties. It is likely that Mary Walker occupied part of no.20 and that the other part was unoccupied.

1921-22 Valuation Roll: There are only 3 houses on the south side of Birwhistle Street.. No.20 is owned by James Palmer, Alderlea, Gatehouse,and occupied by John Hay, joiner

1930-31 Valuation Roll : No.20 is owned by James Palmer, Alderlea, Gatehouse,and occupied by John Hay, tailor.

1940-41 Valuation Roll : There are only 3 houses on the south side of Birwhistle Street. No.20 is owned and occupied by John Hay, gardener.

1950-51 Valuation Roll : 20 Birtwhistle Street is owned and occupied by John Hay, postman & Lizzie Hay.

1960-61 Valuation Roll : 20 Birtwhistle Street is not specifically listed in the 1960-61 valuation roll.

1974-75 Valuation Roll : 20 Birtwhistle Street is owned and occupied by Colin Hay & Miss Mary L. Lockhart.
