**1921-22 Girthon Valuation Roll :** Annie Lockhart, spinster, owned a house in Catherine Street that was occupied by Margaret Lockhart, widow.

**1930-31 Girthon Valuation Roll :** Annie Michison, wife of Albert Michison, Eden Lodge, Armathwaite, by Carlisle, owned a house in Catherine Street that was occupied by Margaret Lockhart, widow.

**1934** | Sold to Thomas Phillips, gamekeeper, Cuil cottage

**1940-41 Girthon Valuation Roll :** Heirs of Thomas H Phillips owned a house in Catherine Street that was occupied by Annie Phillips, widow. Richard Lillie, solicitor, was the agent.

<b>1954</b>	Inherited by Mary Keenan and Mary Watson, granddaughters of Thomas Phillips.
<b>1958</b>	Sold to Allan Campbell, junior, motor mechanic
<b>1971</b>	Allan and Jean Campbell
<b>1996</b>	Sold to Mark and Kirsty Grieve
