1859-60 Girthon Valuation Roll : James Walker, tailor, owned the property no.176 which is listed next to Mary Hornsby, *and this could be her next door neighbour*. The property had an annual rental value <£4 p.a. and hence the occupant(s) did not need to be identified.
James Walker, tailor, lived with his wife, in High Street in 1841, 1851, 1861 & 1871. There is no evidence of children.
