**1930-31 Girthon Valuation Roll :** A house in Catherine Street was owned by the Roman Catholic Diocese of Galloway per Rev. Joseph McHardy, St. Cuthbert's Presbytery, Kirkcudbright, the occupant being William Trainer, shoemaker.

**1940-41 Girthon Valuation Roll :** A house in Catherine Street was owned by the Roman Catholic Diocese, per Rev. William O'Connor, the occupant being Francis Gallagher.
