*In 1841 the census enumerator visited Catherine Street (Back Street) in 3 sections; the east end, the west end, and the central block between Old Ford Lane and Digby Street (Cross Street).*

*We think he started the central portion at Digby Street (No.38), headed east to Old Ford Lane (No.18), then crossed the road to No.17 and headed westwards until he came to No.37(corner of Digby Street on the north side).*

*On that basis there are 27 Catherine Street properties in sequence and we have done our best in allocating the above families to 18 Catherine Street (i.e. the changeover between south and north of the street)*

Robert Paterson, joiner, owned and occupied a house and offices garden in Catherine Street.

**1950-51 Girthon Valuation Roll :**

Robert Patterson, estate worker, owned and occupied the house and offices at 18 Catherine Street.

**1960-61 Girthon Valuation Roll :**

Robert Patterson, retired, owned and occupied the house and offices at 18 Catherine Street.

**1966** Inherited by Isabella McMinn Patterson or Grant

**1978** Improvement grant for Isabella McMinn Patterson or Grant

**1992** Passed from Isabella Grant to her son Duncan Grant, York
