<b>1774</b>	Part on east, now 30, sold by Samuel Ramsay to Andrew McClure, Parks of Cally. <i>[Part on west, now 32, sold to William McMinn, shoemaker, Gatehouse]</i>
<b>1777</b>	Sold to Andrew Carter, weaver in Gatehouse
<b>1795</b>	New Feu to Samuel Carter, schoolmaster, Buittle
<b>1822</b>	Sold to John Coltart with life rent to Janet Carter his wife
