**1921-22 Girthon Valuation Roll :** Peter Stewart Bryan, joiner, 62 Grant Street, Glasgow, owned a house in Catherine Street that was occupied by William Bryan, retired.

**1925** Title of Harriet Hutton or Bryan widow of Peter Stewart Bryan, joiner, Glasgow

**1930-31 Girthon Valuation Roll :** Joseph D Bryan, electrician, 513 St Vincent Street, Glasgow, owned a house in Catherine Street that was occupied by Harriet Bryan, widow.

**1940-41 Girthon Valuation Roll :** Joseph D Bryan, electrician, 14 Tabard Road, Knightswood, Glasgow, owned a house in Catherine Street that was occupied by Mrs Mary Duncan.

**1950-51 Girthon Valuation Roll :** Joseph D Bryan, electrician, 14 Tabard Road, Knightswood, Glasgow, owned and occupied 46 Catherine Street.

**1954** Sold by Joseph Bryan to Robert and Agnes Lawson 35 ft

**1960-61 Girthon Valuation Roll :** Robert & Agnes Lawson owned and occupied 46 Catherine Street.

**1974** Sold by Agnes Lawson to Mary Stephanie Howes
