

The Cut – Whitefield (or Annfield)

“The Cut” was opened in 1823.

1936	Feu charter to Ada Patterson wife of George Patterson, Road surveyor.
1940-41	Valuation Roll. The bungalow named Annfield was owned by Ada Florence Paterson, wife of occupier George W Paterson, road surveyor.
1942	Sold to Lieutenant Colonel Robert Armstrong.

1946	Sold to Daphne Price, wife of Lieutenant Commander Edward Price.
1949	Sold to family of present owners.
1950-51	Valuation Roll, The bungalow called Whitefield was owned and occupied by Mrs Joan M S Steel.
1960-61	Valuation Roll, The bungalow called Whitefields was owned and occupied by Mrs Joan M S Steel.
1974-75	Valuation Roll, The house & garage called Whitefield was owned and occupied by Mrs Joan M S Steel and David Steel.
