Woodside Terrace - Mile End

Before "The Cut" was opened in 1823, the road, or turnpike, into Gatehouse from the East came down Ann Street, past the toll-house (now called Cox's Lodge) and continued along Old Ford Road, until it met a ford across the river. Prior to 1823 there was no road between the clock tower and the mill dam(s). Much, if not all, of this land was part of the Murray Arms grounds.

The cottage got its name from the milestone which was situated beside the house.

We are told that it read "Newton Stewart 18, Castle Douglas 15, London 365".

The milestone was removed during the Second World War for security. It has never been returned.

The Feu Charter for this property was granted to Joseph Tait, painter and glazier, by Alexander Murray of Broughton, in June 1839.
